An effusive display of aromas are detected before even lifting the glass. *Les pierres qui décident* is an example of the intensity that can be attained with a delicate variety such as Sauvignon Blanc. The nose is a medley of orange blossom, key lime, green tea, passionfruit, guava and the elusive “burgeon de cassis”—bud of the cassis flower—presenting a classic varietal smell of Sauvignon Blanc. On the palate, the wine is laser-focused with brilliant intensity and seductive acidity. A wine to savor now or age for many years.
