This wine is both beautifully delicate and intense at the same time. The 2015 "Les pierres qui décident" is a focused and pure Sauvignon Blanc from two vineyards located in the heart of Sonoma County. Aging was carried out in oak barrels and on the lees with minimal stirring. The nose is extremely fragrant with notes of floral perfume, green apple, citrus oil and the classic bud of the cassis plant. The palate is energetic and powerful, with lots of minerality, salinity, and a core for refreshing acidity. This wine drinks great now, but can also cellar for at least a decade.
