Vibrant with a laser focused mouthfeel, the 2016 *Les pierres qui décident* starts with elegant, yet intense notes of key lime, flint and wet stone. A crisp and dry mouthfeel seamlessly transitions into a satisfying grandiose finish which is accentuated by a few short hours of skin contact before going to press. Aging in larger-format puncheon barrels allows the Sauvignon Blanc to retain its vibrancy. This balanced wine leaves one longing for another sip.
