The aromatic intensity of the 2020 Shared Notes Les pierres qui décident simply cannot be contained as it splashes into the glass. Filling the air with bright, concentrated notes of white peach, lime zest, and white flower blossom, this wine sings as signature notes of crushed wet stone and a distinct salinity strike a unique, unmistakable balance. On the palate, crisp stone fruits, lemon meringue, and fresh sea air speak to the potential of this idyllic Russian River Valley vineyard. Crafted through extremely gentle pressing, meticulous oxygen management, and sur lie aging in 132 gallon new French oak puncheons, this Sauvignon Blanc is a model of freshness, complexity, precision and laser focus. Enjoy in its vibrant youth, or cellar for a decade or more to realize the full potential of this fabled varietal.

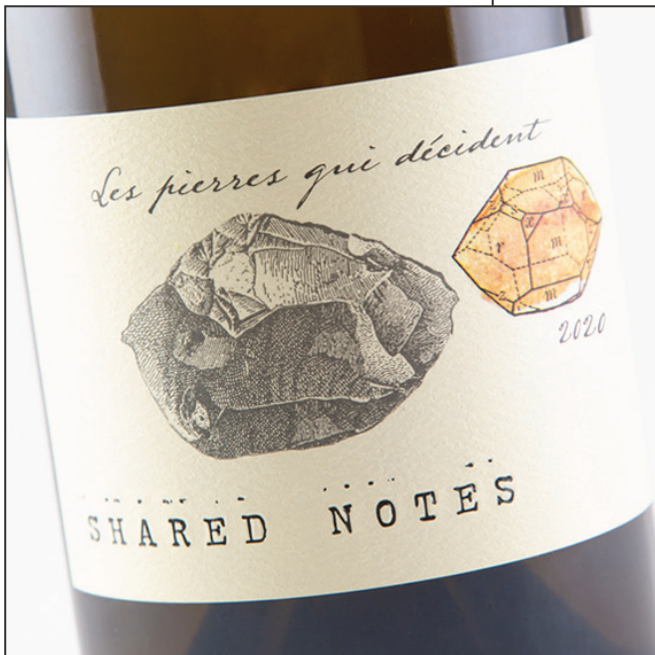
